Booking terms and conditions

All persons entering the facility are admitted only subject to the following booking terms and conditions of the Fleadh Committee and Athboy Convent Community Centre. Athboy Community Centre has a Child Protection Policy in place and all children under 18 years of age are not permitted to be inside the community centre building unaccompanied. This policy is on display in the centre.

The Campsite will accept arrivals from 6pm to 9pm on Thursday 11th July and from 8am on Friday 12th July 2019 until 12 noon on Monday 15th July 2019. All camping equipment must be removed and you must vacate the site by 12pm on Monday 15th July 2019.

- There will be volunteer Fleadh marshals to assist your arrival guide you to your camping pitch and answer your queries.
- Drinking water points will be provided.
- There will be segregated toilet facilities in the Centre with limited showering facilities.
- There will be facilities to boil water for tea / coffee that you bring.
- Other than authorised Fleadh sellers, no trading or selling of any kind is allowed in the campsite.
- Only cars, small car vans and motorbikes will be permitted to enter or park in the camping dedicated Car Park. Please follow marshals instructions.
- No camping will be permitted in the Car Park in cars.
- The use of amplified music is not permitted in the Campsite. Please respect the local community and keep noise to a minimum.
- No animals, other than assistance dogs, are permitted on site.
- By accepting these T&C's, you give your express consent to your, and/or guests and minors, actual/simulated likeness to be included for no fee within any audio or visual recording to be used in any media for any purpose at any time. This includes filming by An Garda Síochána or security staff which may be carried out for the security of attendees and/or the prevention of crime. Please contact us prior to arrival should this be an issue.
- Caravan/Campervan vehicles will receive upon arrival an identification tag for vehicle, and a pass will be provided for each pre-registered attendee including tents. You must display this pass on the tent or camper / caravan.
 - Vehicles towing Caravans must remain with Caravans in situ or be parked in the designated spot.
 - Caravans/Campervan must be road worthy and of a standard to comply with current legislation.
 - Trailer tents will be permitted but the car must be left in the dedicated spot away from camping areas.
 - Electrical charging points are not available on the campsite.
 - Mobile devices may be charged inside the community centre building in designated areas only.
- Some hot food and / Tea / Coffee will be available for purchase at the campsite over the weekend. Alcohol will not be sold on the campsite and is strictly prohibited within the community centre building.
- Children aged 18 years and under must be accompanied at all times by an adult
- Completed forms must be signed and presented in full at the entrance to camping.

- Any item(s), reasonably considered for use as a weapon, which may cause danger, offence or disruption to any other person, are not permitted and will be confiscated.
- Any person carrying illegal items or carrying out illegal activity will be reported to An Garda Síochána and refused entry on site or removed from the campsite.
- The organiser reserves the right to evict a customer and/or refuse admission,
- Anti-social behaviour will not be tolerated and will lead to eviction. Please act responsibly.
- This is a working soccer and pitch area and as such the organisers request that you respect the land on site and use pre-determined walk / driveways.
- Please keep all signed emergency routes/exits free and unobstructed. Please comply with stewards if asked to reposition your Caravan/Campervan/Tent. We thank you in advance for your co-operation.
- The use of drones or similar equipment for any reason is strictly forbidden onsite without written permission from the organiser.
- Please be advised to bring appropriate clothing and footwear and lighting. This is a greenfield site and as such has an outdoor element open to inclement weather.
- The organiser or community centre committee is unable to accept any liability for personal or property damages, losses (including confiscations) or injuries sustained at this event - other than caused as a result of our negligence. Any personal property brought to the event is at your own risk.
- Prosecution may occur if you cause damage to the campsite venue, the campsite infrastructure, or cause harm to any other person at the campsite.
- There will be general waste bins and recycling points provided on site. We encourage you to segregate waste as instructed.
- Open fires including disposable BBQ's are not permitted anywhere onsite. The camping area is a working soccer pitch. Camping gas type stoves are permitted once attended at all times.
 - Anyone involved with starting a fire will be evicted from site.
 - Smoking, including electronic cigarettes, is not permitted inside the community centre buildings and halls. Please do not dispose of cigarette butts.
 - Generators, with the exception of those fixed in campervans (must be Diesel powered only), are not permitted on the camp site.
- Excessive amounts of food, cigarettes and alcohol are not permitted on the campsite. Only bring enough required for personal consumption.
- Under 18's are not permitted to bring or drink alcohol on site.
- Unauthorised professional photography or use of professional recording equipment is prohibited, and zoom lenses, audio visual or cinematographic devices will not be permitted on site.
- The climbing of trees, walls, fences, barriers, staging or other building structures in the event area is forbidden.
- Use of the adjacent football club pitch is not permitted.
- All patrons must familiarise themselves with the emergency exits and must pay due attention to the local marshals instructions.
- In the event of an emergency, the patrons must leave the area of the emergency in a calm and orderly fashion to the **assembly point in the turnaround Car Park** adjacent to the campsite.
- Having fun and enjoying the Leinster Fleadh is permitted!! Please be respectful and considerate of our neighbours and fellow campers and enjoy your stay.

Approaching from Navan / Kells and M3: travel through the town past the Old Darnley Hotel on the left and take the first left turn at the Cosy Corner pub. The campsite will be approximately 200 metres on the right hand side.

Approaching from Mullingar / Delvin: St. James church will be on the left. Turn right there. The campsite will be approximately 200 metres on the right hand side.

Approaching from Trim: As you arrive in Athboy, at the T-Junction turn left. travel through the town past the Old Darnley Hotel on the left and take the first left turn at the Cosy Corner pub. The campsite will be approximately 200 metres on the right hand side.
