



NOTES FOR APPLICANTS

PLEASE READ BEFORE FILLING OUT APPLICATION

- This event is free of charge.
- Each potential participant will attend on just one of the days between Monday July 8th and Friday July 12th, listing their preference on the Application Form.
- There will be four types of workshops encompassing Music, Dance, Percussion and Singing, with each participant getting to experience all four subjects over the course of the day.
- Class sizes will be for twelve people, however depending on the needs the class size may vary slightly.
- Participants in the workshops will assemble at 10am on the morning they are attending, with classes beginning at 10.30.
- Each class will be 45 minutes long with 15 minute intervals between each class.
- Lunch will last for 90 minutes and this will be followed by a group session with all participants.
- Workshops should finish each day by 16.00.
- Participants will be required to bring a packed lunch, suitable to their personal dietary needs. Tea/Coffee will be available at the venue.
